Minimum Requirement:

- A. Grain requirement: Two (2) Ounces Whole Grain: To meet USDA's whole grain-rich, a product must contain at least 50 percent whole grains, and the remaining grain content of the product must be enriched. Must have Product Formulation Statement.
- B. Meat or Meat Alternate Requirement: Two (2) Ounces: Must have Product Formulation Statement.
- C. Each Pizza must be pre-sliced and evenly divided into serving sizes.
- D. Delivery of Pizza must be timely based on lunch periods.
- E. Pizza must be delivered at appropriate temperature.

B. Contract Information

- A. The term of this contract will begin **August 1, 2022** and will expire on **June 30, 2023**.
- B. Contract can be cancelled by either party with notice of 30 days unless agreed upon.
- C. Camden County Schools Child Nutrition Program reserves the right to renew the contract for a period not to exceed five (5) terms of one (1) year, upon mutual agreement of both parties.
